Code of Conduct

1. All campers will be under the supervision of their Cabin Leader at all times.
2. We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. We ask that you be very discretionary on what you bring to camp. We ask that no electronic devices (including cell phones) be used once our "Lights Out" time begins.
3. Alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. All medication brought to camp must be left with the camp nurse.
4. No fireworks, firearms, knives or other weapons are allowed on the camp property.
5. All campers are expected to attend all camp activities unless excused by the Camp Nurse or Head Cabin Leader(s).
6. All campers and workers must adhere to the dress code. In general, clothing deemed immodest or inappropriate for particular activities will not be allowed at camp. The following guidelines should be observed:

RECREATION: Bring play clothes (no tank tops, strapless tops or halter tops — shorts of modest length are allowed); swimsuits and cover-ups (girls are encouraged to wear one piece suits); and athletic shoes

FOR EVENING WORSHIP (Teen Camp Only): Clothing considered appropriate for normal Sunday evening and/or Wednesday worship service/Youth Group should be worn to Youth Camp evening worship services. We honor God by how we present ourselves during a worship service.

7. All automobiles are to remain parked until camp is dismissed. No one may leave the campground without special permission from the Camp Director. This includes campers and staff.
8. Everyone at camp will be expected to help keep the grounds and facilities clean. Dorm rooms will be inspected daily.
9. No camper is to be out of their dorms after "Lights Out" or before "Wake Up" call. Failure to uphold this expectation may result in Camper being sent home without refund.
10. Any breach of proper conduct or disregard of camp rules can result in disciplinary action. Serious or repeat infractions will result in dismissal from camp without refund.

- Head Check:** In keeping with the policy of many schools and child-care facilities, every camper and staff member will be checked for head lice before they are able to check into their room. This process will be handles very discreetly and professionally. However, anyone with head lice or nits will not be admitted to camp. **It is recommended that each camper be checked before they leave home.**
- Visitors at Camp:** Because visits can be very disruptive to the camp schedule, we ask that none be made during the day. However, everyone is welcome to attend our worship service. For security reasons, all visitors will be asked to check in, wear a guest badge and leave the campground as the completion of the evening service.
- Check In:** Senior Camp - Saturday morning , June 29th
Junior Camp - Wednesday afternoon, July 3rd
- Check out:** Senior Camp - Wednesday morning, July 3rd
Junior Camp - Saturday morning, July 6th
- Medication:** Any necessary medication should be brought to camp in their original container. All medication will be distributed by the Camp Nurse at the Nurse's Station.
- T-shirts:** Please take notice that we have a new t-shirt policy this year. Please include \$12 with your registration to ensure you receive your t-shirt. This option is available to every camper during the early bird and regular registration period. We will be very limited on extra shirts after this period and may not have your size available for purchase if you choose not to preorder. This is one way for us to keep the camp cost affordable for everyone.
- Spending Money:** We are attempting something new and exciting this year. We will be a totally cashless camp this summer. We will be selling camp bracelets worth \$10. These bracelets act as a credit system and can be used to purchase items at different location at camp. This will help campers not lose their cash or be taken by other campers as their names will be on the bracelets.
